Pre-Intermediate Level 2 ALC Syllabus

AOS's **Pre-Intermediate Level 2 Arabic Language Course** will give those with some knowledge of Arabic the chance to develop their written and spoken Arabic. The course has the primary aim of promoting cultural exchange through the opportunity to learn and practice Arabic.

The Pre-Intermediate Level 1 Course covers:

- Verb conjugation in the past tense (verbs with vowels: عاش، نام، كان) using first, second and third person singular pronouns
- More present tense verbs
- Question words (practicing those from before and لماذا) and how to respond (e.g. using "لأن")
- Imperative verbs
- The use of "YOU" in the object form as part of a verb. Example: أحبك
- All possessive forms (e.g. بيتنا "our house")
- Regular feminine and masculine forms
- More comparatives (e.g. أفضل، أحسن، أكبر) and superlatives (e.g. الأحسن، الأكبر، الأصغر)
- The use of لديّ, classical of "I have"
- The use of لي, "belong to me"

Throughout the course, there will be constant revision of the subjects covered in previous levels.

In each lesson, you will practice reading Arabic words and phrases with vowel markers, "stressed" words, and shaddah (شَدَّة) (emphasis/double letter marker). You will listen to and repeat phrases and you will use the grammar and vocab to construct your own short sentences.

Please note the content covered each lesson will vary depending on the students' abilities.

The course roughly follows Gateway to Arabic Book 2, which will be emailed to enrolled students before the start of term, though we recommend buying a physical copy.

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
